



## VOLUNTEER SAFETY PROTOCOLS ON SITE

If, prior to your volunteer day, you or someone close to you is showing signs and/or symptoms of COVID19, please follow CDC protocols and contact [CharlieSchraw@HabitatBoston.org](mailto:CharlieSchraw@HabitatBoston.org) to reschedule your build day.

Should you start to feel ill during the course of your day, please notify Habitat site personnel, leave the site and follow CDC guidelines.

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### ***Upon Arrival***

- Masks are required to be worn on site while indoors or when 6' social distancing is not possible. If you do not have them, masks will be available on site.
- A Habitat Staff member will check your temperature with a touchless thermometer upon arrival at the gate. Anyone showing an elevated temperature will not be permitted entry to site. **Do not enter site until your temperature has been taken.**
- Orientation and safety introduction will take place outside.
- Please keep a distance of 6 feet from others whenever possible and wear a mask when this is not possible.
- Pre-sanitized tools will be provided by site personnel on an individual basis. Tools are not to be shared under any circumstances.
- Lunch break will be outside weather permitting. In case of inclement weather, volunteers will be dispersed throughout the units at a minimum of 6 feet apart.

### ***Stations***

- A hand wash station is located on site and should be used frequently.
    - Soap/hand sanitizer & disposable towels are provided.
  - A tool sanitization station is located on site.
    - All tools and equipment will be cleaned and sanitized once a volunteer is done using them. Ask site personnel for assistance.
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**\*\*Additional signage is posted throughout site to remind our valued volunteers of these protocols\*\***

**As always, the safety of our volunteers is our number one priority. It is up to the discretion of our staff to determine a volunteer's ability to meet these safety requirements.**
