



Starting & Maintaining a Campus Chapter

Before becoming an official Campus Chapter you will need to:

- Register with your school's Student Activities Council or equivalent
- Find a committed faculty/staff advisor (possibly through your Student Activities Council or equivalent)

To start and maintain your status as a Campus Chapter:

- Exhibit a willingness to offer direct service, fundraise, and serve as an advocate for affordable homeownership in the Greater Boston community
- Create a mission statement and set yearly goals
- Meet virtually with Habitat Greater Boston at least once per school year

Your status as a Campus Chapter includes:

- The opportunity to schedule Build Days, dependent on build site availability and the Chapter's ability to meet fundraising goals
- The opportunity to volunteer at our ReStore, a group opportunity exclusive to our Campus Chapters
- Educational and branding materials from Habitat Greater Boston
- An invitation for chapter leadership to attend Habitat Greater Boston's annual Campus Chapter Summit
